MTSU's Department of Educational Leadership Will offer M. Ed. and/or Ed. S Classes

**Masters and/or Educational Specialist Degree can be presented at your Off-Campus Site
By MTSU's Department of Educational Leadership**

The College of Education Department of Educational Leadership does offer the opportunity of an On-site Graduate Cohort Program which is designed to lead to a Master of Education Degree (M.Ed.) in Curriculum and Instruction; or, for those who currently possess a Master's Degree a program may be offered leading to an Educational Specialist Degree (Ed.S.) with a major in either Curriculum & Instruction or Administration and Supervision. (30 hour Program.) Educational Specialist Degree (Ed.S) in Administration & Supervision - Instructional Leadership Licensure Path (ILL-A). (33 Hour Program) *(This program is for those pursuing State Administrator Licensure)*

Classes will be conducted at a local site.

Classes will be presented on weekends using the model below:

The model for the Masters of Education and Ed.S Programs (M.Ed.) are as follows:

2 (two) courses are offered each semester until the program is completed with 30 or 33 credit hours. The classes are typically offered Friday evenings and all day Saturday. Three weekend sessions will be necessary to complete 1 (ONE) course. There will be a total of ten (10) or eleven (11) courses offered (depending on the program) on-site.

These entire programs will be offered in five (5) consecutive semesters (counting the Summer Semester). For example a program starting in a Fall Semester would continue through that **Fall - Spring - Summer - Fall - end in Spring.**

Classes will begin the semester following the interest meeting if there are a sufficient numbers of students enrolled to meet the enrollment requirements.
