Deposit varies depending on credit check or customer history with Caney Fork as well as previous 12-month highest usage. Must pay all previous balances. Must have valid photo id. Membership fee of \$5 & meter-set fee of \$25. Also, rental/ lease agreement is required for renters or sales/closing papers for home owners. www.caneyforkec.com

McMinnville Electric: 473-3144

Deposit based on "Twice the Average Bill" for residence. Has \$50 Service fee- Must pay service fee & at least 1/2 deposit at time of turn on with the balance due in 2 weeks. Also, need verification for renters and 2 forms of ID. Can apply for services online. Also, may pay bill with automated bill pay hotline @ 931-507-4637. No service fee for bills under \$300. www.mesystem.net

Middle TN Natural Gas: 473-8494

\$50 non-refundable turn-on fee & credit check. Application is also required. If credit check indicates, will be \$150 deposit. Photo ID and Social Security number required to do credit check. www.mtng.com

Cell Phone Assistance

Only one Lifeline or ACP discount is allowed per "independent economic household" (household). If you live together and share money, you are one household. If you live together and don't share money, you are 2+ households.
