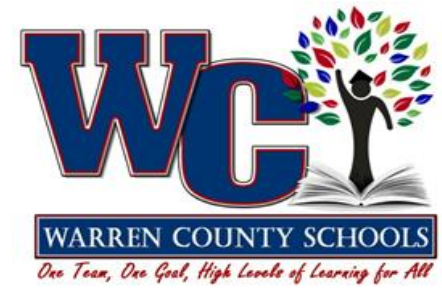

What Homeless Families Need To Know

- Children and youth experiencing homelessness have the right to attend school.
- A permanent address is not needed to enroll in school.
- Children in homeless situations have the right to stay in the school they attended before becoming homeless or where they were last enrolled.
- Schools must provide a written explanation if a placement dispute occurs.
- A homeless child cannot be denied school enrollment just because school records or other enrollment documentation are not immediately available and must be enrolled immediately.
- A homeless child has the right to participate in extracurricular activities and all federal, state, and local programs for which the student is eligible
- Unaccompanied youth, homeless youth not living with a parent or guardian have these same rights.



McKinney – Vento Definition of Homeless

*Do not have a permanent home

*Live in motels, hotels, or camping grounds

*Live in cars, parks, or public places

*Live in abandoned buildings, sub-standard buildings, or similar settings.

*Share housing with other persons due to loss of housing or economic hardships
